

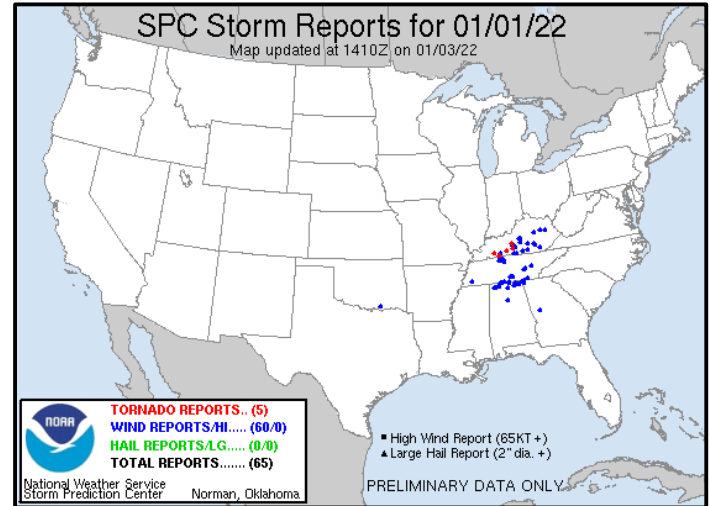

Severe Weather Activity

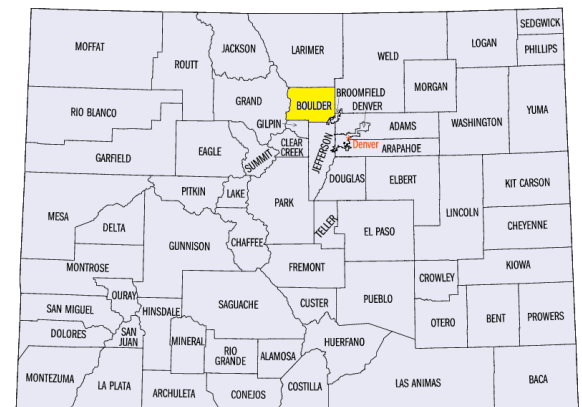
- Damage was reported in parts of Alabama after severe storms and possible tornadoes hit Kentucky and caused damage and forced water rescues on New Year's Day.
- Homes were damaged and roads closed in Hazel Green, Alabama, about 15 miles north of Huntsville.
- Kentucky Gov. Andy Beshear declared a state of emergency in the state on Saturday afternoon due to flooding and severe weather damage.
- A possible tornado damaged structures in the Bowling Green, Kentucky, area just three weeks after a devastating tornado outbreak killed 17 in Warren County alone.
- In Hopkinsville, in southwest Kentucky, a possible tornado knocked down power lines and damaged buildings in the east side of the downtown area.
- Multiple water rescues were needed in Green County, in central Kentucky as floodwaters rose.
- Others needed rescue in Pike County, in the far eastern part of the state. The water there rose high enough to enter and damage homes and churches, Kentucky Today reported.
- Numerous rescues were needed in Barren County as well.
- Kentucky Gov. Andy Beshear said that many roads were closed and flooded in Green, Barren, Taylor, Adair, Owsley, Breathitt and Casey counties.



Declaration Activity

DR 4634 Colorado

- On Saturday, FEMA announced that federal disaster assistance has been made available to the state of Colorado to supplement state and local recovery efforts in the areas affected by wildfires and straight-line winds beginning on December 30, 2021 and continuing.
- The Marshall Fire began late Thursday morning amid high-speed winds and rapidly grew to approximately 6,000 acres in Boulder County, fueled by dry grasses, the remnants of a nearly snowless November and December.
- A snowstorm Friday put a stop to further spreading, but not before the flames had swallowed entire suburban neighborhoods in Louisville and Superior, destroying 991 homes and damaging 127.
- More than 30,000 people in Boulder County were asked to evacuate on Thursday. Two people are missing.
