Tropical Activity

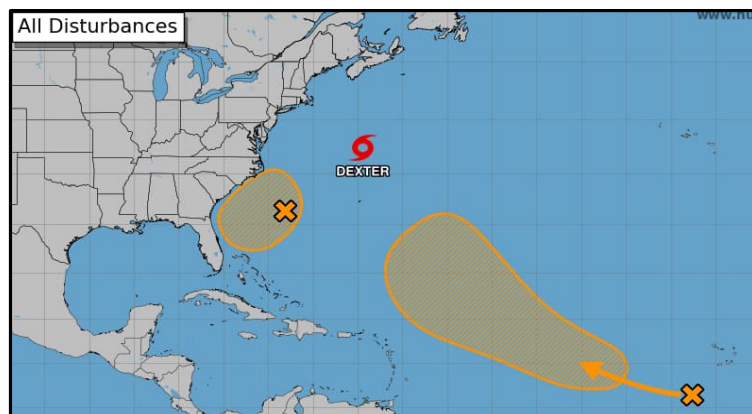
Atlantic - Tropical Storm Dexter

- Tropical Storm Dexter has started to weaken after forming off the East Coast in the Atlantic Ocean on Sunday night.
- Forecasters say it could restrengthen in the coming days as it continues to move away from the U.S.
- Maximum sustained winds within Tropical Storm Dexter have dropped to about 40 mph with some higher gusts.
- Currently located about 345 miles north of Bermuda and is moving off to the northeast near 12 mph.
- The NHC said Dexter is expected to make a gradual turn toward the east-northeast over the next few days.



Atlantic - Disturbance #1

- Located several hundred miles off the coast of the southeastern United States.
- Environmental conditions appear favorable for gradual development of this system, and a tropical depression could form by the latter portion of this week or week-end.
- Moving slowly westward but will turn northward by this weekend.
- Formation chance through 48 hours – Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 7 days – Medium (40%)



Atlantic - Disturbance #2

- Located over the far eastern tropical Atlantic and currently producing disorganized shower and thunderstorm activity, primarily to the southwest of the wave axis.
- Environmental conditions are forecast to be conducive for gradual development during the next few days, and a tropical depression could form late this week or over the weekend as the system moves generally west-northwestward across the central tropical or subtropical Atlantic.
- Formation chance through 48 hours – Low (0%)
- Formation chance through 7 days – Medium (50%)
