## Flash Flood Threat California

- A slow-moving storm is drenching Southern California with heavy rain and brings the threats of flooding and debris flows in recent burn areas, as well as rockslides and mudslides into Friday.
- Flood watches are in effect for parts of southwest California, including Los Angeles through Friday morning and San Diego through Friday afternoon.



- Rain and embedded thunderstorms could cause extensive flooding on roadways, especially in low-lying areas, the National Weather Service said. Creeks, streams and rivers will see increased flows and possible flooding.
- Debris flows are possible in recent burn areas like the South Fire burn scar in Ventura County and rockslides and mudslides are also a possibility along canyon and mountain roads.
- Lower elevation locations of Southern California can expect rainfall totals of 2 to 4 inches. Totals will be higher measuring between 4 to 8 inches in the foothills and mountains below snow level (7,000 feet or lower).
