

Earthquake Activity

Washington & Oregon

- Seismic activity in the Pacific Northwest has been taking place offshore from Oregon as well as in Washington state.
- Two earthquakes struck off the Oregon coastline Monday night.
- The first earthquake struck at 11:10 p.m. on December 28 and registered as a 5.7-magnitude seismic event, according to the U.S. Geological Survey.
- At a depth of 10 kilometers (six miles), the epicenter was located 205 kilometers (127 miles) west of Bandon, Oregon: 270 kilometer



miles) west of Bandon, Oregon; 270 kilometers (167 miles) southwest of Newport, Oregon; and 356 kilometers (221 miles) southwest of Salem, Oregon.

- It was later followed by a 3.2-magnitude quake at 2:15 a.m., also a depth of 10 kilometers.
- Meanwhile, a cluster of small earthquakes has been taking place in the Bremerton area of Washington state over the past month, including a 3.2-magnitude quake on December 15.
- A 3.0-magnitude quake, at a depth of 20 kilometers (12 miles) struck at 6:36 a.m. yesterday (December 29).
- The epicenter was located seven kilometers (four miles) northeast of Carnation, Washington; 15 kilometers (nine miles) north of Snoqualmie, Washington; and 107 kilometers (66 miles) northeast of Olympia, Washington.
- On December 28, two earthquakes that struck King and Snohomish counties—one was 2.9magnitude and the other was 2.2-magnitude—were reported as felt.
- Meanwhile, a 4.5-magnitude quake occurred west of the northern end of Vancouver Island on December 25.

COVID-19 Update

- The US set two more devastating Covid-19 records as it counted down the hours to the end of what has been a calamitous year for the nation.
- On Tuesday, it recorded more than 3,700 new deaths linked to the virus, a chilling new high.
- The US also reported the most Covid-19 hospitalizations, with more than 124,600 patients nationwide, according to the COVID Tracking Project.
- Experts have warned the U.S. could see even worse Covid-19 numbers in January fueled by this month's holiday gatherings and travel.
- According to data compiled by Johns Hopkins University, there have been more than 19.51 million cases and at least 338,656 deaths in the U.S.
- More than 82.07 million cases and at least 1.79 million deaths worldwide.
