

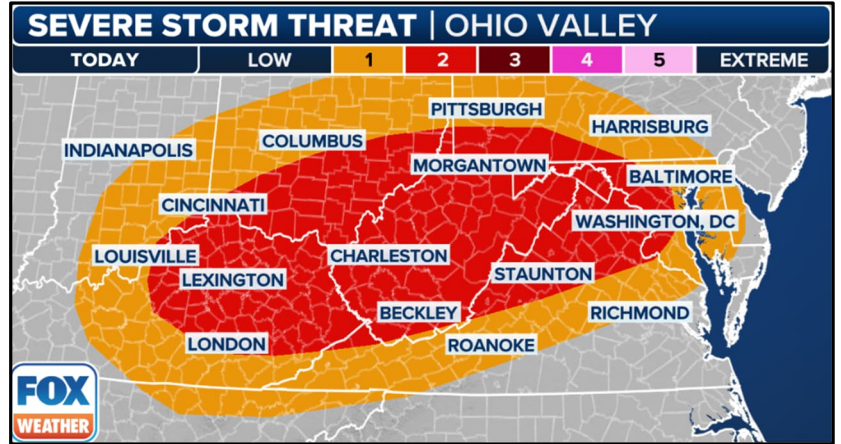

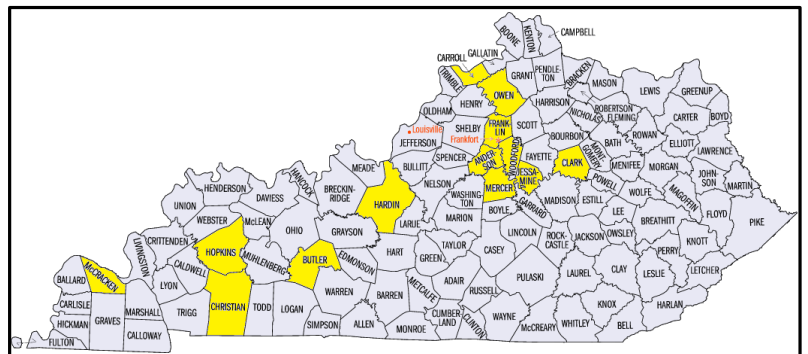
## Severe Weather Outlook Ohio Valley & Mid-Atlantic

- More than 32 million people from the Ohio Valley to the mid-Atlantic are bracing for the possibility of severe weather as a fast-moving cold front plow across the region on Monday.
- Cities across portions of Kentucky, Ohio, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Maryland and Washington, D.C., are at a heightened risk of powerful thunderstorms starting Monday afternoon.
- The FOX Forecast Center said there is still some uncertainty regarding how warm and unstable the atmosphere will become ahead of the cold front.
- Conditions could become favorable for strong storms to develop, including the possibility of rotating supercell thunderstorms.
- The main threats from thunderstorms that develop will be damaging wind gusts and large hail. However, some tornadoes are also possible. The thunderstorms can also produce life-threatening lightning and torrential rain.



## Disaster Declaration Request Kentucky

- On April 11<sup>th</sup> Governor Andy Beshear requested Individual Assistance for the following 13 counties: Anderson, Butler, Carroll, Christian, Clark, Franklin, Hardin, Hopkins, Jessamine, Mercer, McCracken, Owen, Woodford.
- Over 70 Kentucky counties have declared states of emergency.
- On April 2, the Governor declared a state of emergency ahead of the first round of severe storms. President Donald Trump approved the request on April 4, 2025.
- The Governor toured flooding damage in Louisville and tornado damage in Jeffersontown last week.
- As of April 10<sup>th</sup>, 353 state roadways were closed, 341 by high water and 12 by mudslides or rock-slides.



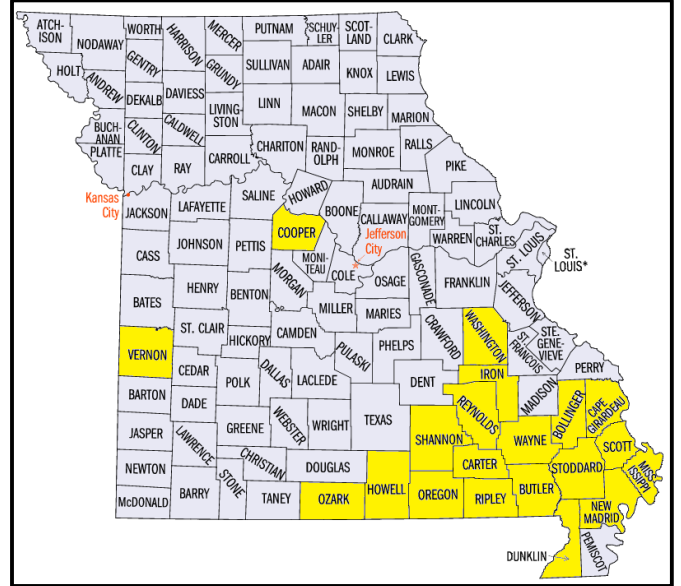

## Preliminary Damage Assessments Missouri

- Missouri Governor Mike Kehoe has requested joint preliminary damage assessments from the Federal Emergency Management Agency following severe storms and flooding that began on March 30.
- Joint assessments have been requested for the following counties: Bollinger, Butler, Cape Girardeau, Cooper, Carter, Dunklin, Howell, Iron, Mississippi, New Madrid, Oregon, Ozark, Reynolds, Ripley, Scott, Shannon, Stoddard, Vernon, Washington, and Wayne. Additional counties may be added as further damage reports are submitted by local officials.
- Starting Tuesday, April 15, six teams consisting of representatives from FEMA, the State Emergency Management Agency, the U.S. Small Business Administration, and local emergency managers will assess damage. The teams will verify losses to determine whether Missouri meets the criteria to request Individual Assistance from FEMA.
