



WSP USA INSPECTION SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

March 3, 2026

Severe Weather Outlook Central U.S.

- Starting Tuesday evening, scattered thunderstorms could develop in the mid-Mississippi Valley.
- A level 1/5 risk has been issued by the NOAA Storm Prediction Center for Tuesday, with large hail being the biggest threat.
- As we transition into Wednesday, warm, humid air will spread northward from east-central Texas into the Arkansas and Louisiana regions.
- At this point, thunderstorms will likely develop from Central Oklahoma into Southern Missouri.
- Forecast models are predicting a decent amount of storm energy ahead of this, with stronger winds moving through the Southern Plains by Wednesday afternoon.
- A few supercells are possible, which is the greatest overall risk.
- The storm system will move into the mid-Mississippi Valley on Thursday and at the same time, a cold front pushes southeast into the Arkansas, Louisiana, and Texas regions.
- Starting on Friday moist air will become unstable enough to support scattered thunderstorms, and the greatest risk of severe weather stretches from Central Texas into the lower Missouri Valley, including popular locations such as Dallas, Oklahoma City, and Kansas City.
- The main threats to these areas are large hail and damaging wind gusts; a few tornadoes can't be ruled out, especially if storms become more organized.
- By Saturday, a stronger, larger upper-level trough is expected to form over the Western U.S., reinforcing warm, humid air.
