## Flood Activity

## Puerto Rico

- American Red Cross disaster workers are responding in Puerto Rico after severe weather and torrential rains brought widespread flooding and several landslides to the island last weekend.
- Families living in the municipalities of Cataño, Dorado, Vega Alta, Vega Baja, Maunabo and Toa Baja are the most heavily affected.
- According to the National Weather Service, Toa Alta received nearly 16 inches of rain over two days. Along the northern coast, flooding was made worse by waves reaching up to 13 feet.

- Some 20 Red Cross volunteers from different parts of the island are in the affected areas to support the communities, with more volunteers on their way.
- At this time, more than 200 homes are known to have sustained major damage and we anticipate that number may grow.
- In the coming days, Red Cross volunteers will finish assessing the damage to homes and start connecting directly with families to help them recover from this challenging situation.
