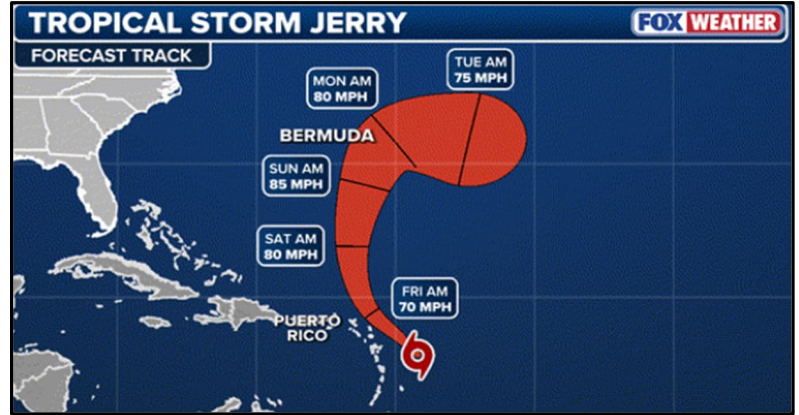

October 9, 2025

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Tropical Storm Jerry

- Tropical Storm Watches remain in effect for portions of the Leeward Islands as a struggling Tropical Storm Jerry continues to spin across the Atlantic.
- Jerry is located less than 400 miles to the east-southeast of the northern Leeward Islands and is moving off to the west-northwest at 20 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds are holding steady at 65 mph with some higher gusts, and gradual strengthening is expected over the next few days and still forecasted to become a hurricane later this week or over the weekend.
- Through Friday, about 2-4 inches of rain with some locally higher amounts of up to 6 inches is expected across the Leeward Islands and the British and U.S. Virgin Islands.



Flash Flood Threat

East U.S.

- A powerful area of low pressure is expected to develop along the East Coast this weekend and pack heavy rain, high winds and bring coastal flooding to the Carolinas and mid-Atlantic.
- The coastal storm will likely be of the nor'easter variety, meaning it will pack strong winds that blow from the northeast and heavy precipitation.
- Anywhere from the Carolinas to southern New England is at risk of being impacted by the potentially strong coastal storm beginning Friday.
- Heavy rain will create a flash flooding threat from the Carolinas to the mid-Atlantic this weekend.
- According to the FOX Forecast Center, rain closer to the coast looks to amount to a widespread 2-3 inches through Monday.
- Localized amounts closer to 3-5 inches are possible, with wind gusts of 30-50 mph possible along the Northeast coast through Sunday and into early Monday.
