## Severe Storms & Tornado Activity

- At least one person has been killed by a falling tree on the third day of a severe weather outbreak sweeping across the South and Midwest.
- Stephen McClellan, emergency management director in Cleveland County, Arkansas, told weather.com Wednesday night that a 20year-old woman died when a tree fell on a mobile home in the community of Rison, about 45 miles south of Little Rock.



- Similar reports were coming in from several areas around the South Wednesday night, including downed trees and power lines near Mayfield, Kentucky, which was devastated by a tornado in December.
- There were reports of a brick wall collapsed in Jonestown in Coahoma County, Mississippi, about 65 miles southwest of Memphis, and an emergency management official in Desoto County, Mississippi, said people were trapped in a home after a tree fell on it in Olive Branch, a suburb of Memphis.
- According to PowerOutage.US, Mississippi, Louisiana and Kentucky all have over 20,000 customers without power. Mississippi leads the way with over 43,000 customers in the dark. Louisiana has just over 30,000 and Kentucky with more than 27,000 reported outages.
- The storms are part of a severe weather outbreak sweeping across several states, including a tornado that injured at least 23 people Tuesday in central Texas.
- Since Monday, the outbreak of severe storms from this weather system has produced near 550 reports of damaging winds, large hail and tornadoes in the central U.S.

## Wildfire Activity New Mexico

- Two people have died in the McBride Fire raging in New Mexico.
- The McBride Fire, which started Tuesday afternoon, has grown to 5,381 acres and was 0% contained as of Wednesday evening, according to the New Mexico Fire information website.
- The flames have destroyed or damaged more than 200 structures, local officials said, and many Ruidoso residents were told to evacuate.
- The McBride Fire is one of five wildfires -- including the Nogal Canyon, Overflow, Big Hole and Hermit's Peak fires -- that have prompted thousands to evacuate as the blazes have scorched over 13,000 acres in New Mexico this week.
- Strong winds and hot, dry weather have fueled the wildfires.

## Severe Weather Outlook

- A round of gusty and locally severe thunderstorms will dart through the eastern United States on Thursday and target areas from New England to northern Florida.
- The storms will be the last gasp of a major storm system that roared across the nation's midsection this week and produced a fierce blizzard as well as damaging hail and tornadoes.
- The risk of severe weather from Florida to
   Massachusetts and Vermont will be significantly lower than the powerful storms that brought
   hail to the size of softballs over the southern Plains and tornadoes that tore through
   communities from Texas to lowa on Tuesday and Wednesday.
- However, the storms can still pack a punch and hit some neighborhoods hard with strong wind gusts, torrential downpours and hail on Thursday afternoon and evening.
