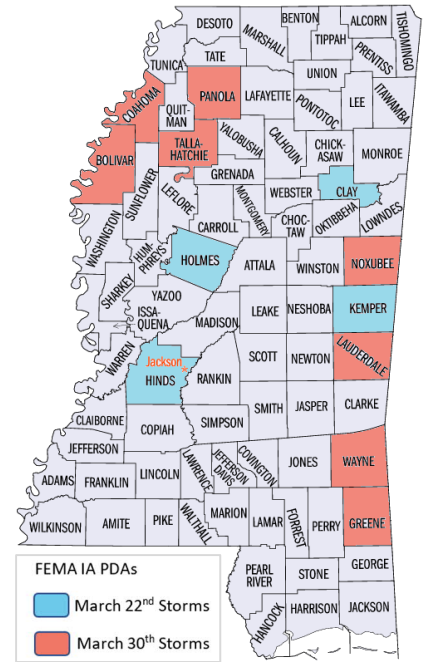
Severe Storms & Tornado Activity

Mississippi – March 22nd Storms

- The National Weather Service Jackson has confirmed 25 tornadoes that swept across the state.
- Three injuries were reported to MEMA due to the storms (Clay, Copiah, and Holmes).
- We have reports from 16 counties that 252 homes have sustained some type of damage.
- At this time, 22 are classified as destroyed, and 34 are considered to have major damage in Attala, Clay, Hinds, Holmes, Jefferson, Kemper, Madison, Smith, Warren, and Yazoo counties.
- FEMA has completed individual assistance preliminary damage assessments in the following counties: Clay, Hinds, Holmes, Kemper.

Mississippi – March 30th Storms

- At least twenty- one tornadoes have been confirmed by the National Weather Service to have occurred in Mississippi on that date.
- Six injuries have been reported to MEMA (1- Bolivar, 1-Holmes, 1-Lafayette, 2-Noxubee, 1-Panola).
- Twenty-four counties have provided preliminary damage numbers to MEMA.

 - Jackson – 13 Homes
 - Lafayette – 4 Homes; 2 Businesses
 - Lauderdale– 5 Homes; 4 Businesses
 - Leake– 19 Homes; 27 Farms
 - Leflore– 8 Homes; 3 Businesses; 1 Farm
 - Madison– 5 Homes
 - Marshall – 4 Homes
 - Panola– 133 Homes; 1 Business; 2 Farms
 - Smith– 7 Homes; 3 Businesses
 - Tallahatchie– 62 Homes
 - Warren– 37 Homes; 1 Business
 - Washington– 2 Homes

Texas – March 21st Storms

- Damage assessments are currently on going through out the regions that were affected by the tornadoes and high winds that impacted the state on March 21.
- On March 22, 2022, Governor Abbott issued a disaster declaration for the following counties: Bastrop, Cass, Cooke, Grayson, Guadalupe, Houston, Jack, Madison, Marion, Montague, Nacogdoches, Panola, Rusk, Upshur, Williamson, and Wise.

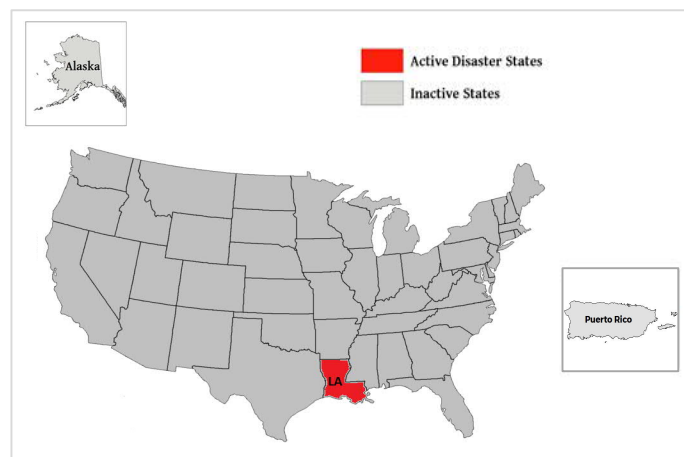
