
Tropical Activity Atlantic – Hurricane Humberto (CAT 4)


- The storm is currently located over 300 miles south of Bermuda, where a tropical storm watch is in effect.
- Humberto underwent rapid intensification on Friday, with its maximum sustained winds jumping from 65 mph to 145 in only 24 hours. The storm then went on to become the second Category 5 hurricane in the Atlantic Basin so far this season.
- Though it is back to Category 4 strength, Humberto is expected to remain a powerful, major hurricane for several days.

Atlantic – Tropical Storm Imelda

- Tropical Storm Imelda is anticipated to strengthen during the next few days, and the system is forecast to become a hurricane by late Monday or Tuesday.
- The system is expected to turn sharply to the eastnortheast moving away from the southeastern U.S. by the middle part of this week.
- The rainfall could result in flash and urban flooding, with rainfall totals of 1-2" (locally up to 4") in the coastal Carolinas.
