
Tropical Activity

Disturbance 1

- Tropical wave moving off the west coast of Africa
- Any development should be slow to occur
- Formation chance 48-hour Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (20%)

Disturbance 2

- A tropical wave more than 1,000 miles E of the Windward Islands
- Some gradual development is possible
- Formation chance 48-hour Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (20%)



Flood Activity

<u>Illinois</u>

- More rain is on the way Monday after Chicago saw its worst flooding in two years.
- Heavy rain Sunday caused high-standing water on area roadways and flooded homes across the city. Some portions recorded up to five inches of rain fall.
- A flash flood warning was issued until 12:30 p.m. local time for most of Cook County on Sunday.
- Hundreds of residents reported their basements had flooded with some even reporting as much as 6 inches of water, according to Block Club Chicago.
- In Rockford, Sunday's rainfall total broke the city's previous record, the National Weather Service says. At 4.34 inches, Sunday ranked as the third heaviest September rainfall on record, and Rockford's 12th heaviest rainfall of all time.
- But Sunday's highest rainfall totals were seen in the city.
- By noon, Ravenswood Manor had already recorded 4.3 inches of rain. As of Sunday evening, Lincoln Square picked up 5.90 inches of rain, Portage Park recorded 5.86 inches of rain, and Albany Park recorded 5.63 inches of rain.
- More than 450 flights were delayed, and more than a dozen were canceled from Chicago O'Hare International Airport as of Sunday afternoon.

Declaration Request

Virginia

- On September 9th, the Governor of Virginia requested a major disaster declaration for flooding and mudslides that occurred July 13th-14th, 2022.
- He is requesting individual assistance for Buchanan County.
- Flooding on July 12 destroyed 30 homes and damaged nearly 100 others.
- Virginia Governor Glenn Youngkin declared a state of emergency July 13.
