## Tropical Activity

### Atlantic – Tropical Storm Fay

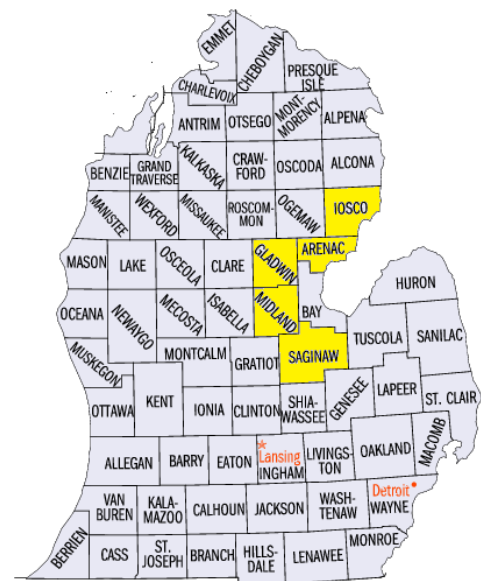
- Located 55 miles SSE of Ocean City, MD, moving N at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Fay became a tropical storm late Thursday afternoon as it was centered just off the Outer Banks of North Carolina.
- Strengthening to a hurricane is not anticipated due to the proximity to the coast, upcoming landfall and its path over progressively cooler waters on Friday.
- The center is forecast to move near the Mid-Atlantic coast today and move inland over the Mid-Atlantic/Northeast on Saturday.
- Tropical Storm Warnings in effect for Fenwick Island, DE to Watch Hill, RI including Long Island and Long Island Sound and southern DE Bay.
- 2-4 inches with isolated rainfall of 7 inches expected near the track from the lower Eastern Shore of MD and DE northward into NJ, eastern PA, southeast NY and southern New England.
- Isolated tornadoes possible today over southeast NY and southern New England.



## Declaration Activity

### Michigan

- President Donald Trump has approved a major disaster declaration for mid-Michigan counties affected by the flood of May 19.
- The president's approval of the declaration opens federal funding for affected individuals in Arenac, Gladwin, Iosco, Midland and Saginaw counties.
- Two dams failed after days of heavy rain. The resulting torrent of water created a record flood on the Tittabawassee River.
- More than ten thousand people were forced to evacuate their homes.
- The 500-year flood caused an estimated quarter billion dollars in damage to private property and public infrastructure.
