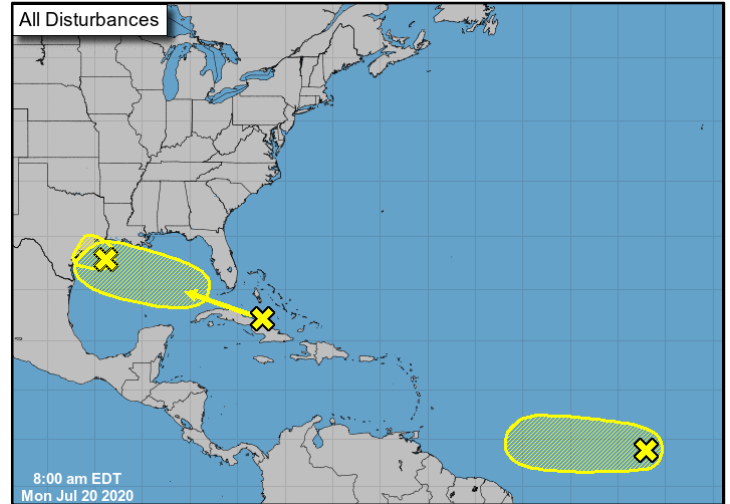

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Located over the Bahamas, central and eastern Cuba, and adjacent Atlantic waters
- Expected to move WNW through the Straits of Florida today, over the southeastern Gulf of Mexico by Tuesday, across the central Gulf on Wednesday, and reach the northwestern Gulf on Thursday
- Could become a little more conducive for development once it reaches the Gulf of Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)



Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- Currently 1,000 miles WSW of Cabo Verde Islands moving W at 10-15 mph
- Expected to be marginally conducive for development during the next few days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Atlantic – Disturbance 3

- Located over northwestern Gulf of Mexico
- Little additional development is expected before it moves inland over Texas tonight or Tuesday
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)
