



July 22, 2020

Alaska Earthquake

- A powerful 7.8-magnitude earthquake struck off the coast of Alaska, south of the Aleutian Islands, in the wee hours of Wednesday morning (July 22), prompting fear of a tsunami, the U.S. Geological Survey reported.
- The earthquake hit at 2:12 a.m. ET (06:12 UTC) about 65 miles (105 kilometers) southeast of Perryville, Alaska, and 528 miles southwest of Anchorage. The tsunami warning, which had been issued for areas in south Alaska, the Alaska Peninsula and the Aleutian Islands, was later canceled.



Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Located over the eastern Gulf of Mexico
- Expected to move WNW over the central Gulf today, and reach the northwestern Gulf on Thursday and Friday
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)



Atlantic – Tropical Storm Gonzalo

- Tropical Storm Gonzalo formed Wednesday morning in the mid-Atlantic region as it continues moving west, according to the National Hurricane Center.
- Gonzalo is moving 12 mph west toward the Southern Windward Islands and has maximum sustained winds of 45 mph, the NHC said.
- The storm's five day path has Gonzalo moving slightly northwest, making it unclear at this time whether or not Florida will be impacted.



East Pacific – Tropical Storm Douglas

- Tropical Storm Douglas maintained its strength and is “expected to become a hurricane soon,” according to the National Weather Service in Miami.
- The storm’s five-day forecast has Douglas threatening the Big Island as a tropical storm with maximum sustained winds of 60 mph by Sunday.
- Forecasters predict the storm will peak as a Category 2 hurricane with maximum sustained winds of 105 mph on Thursday as it approaches the Central Pacific.
- It is expected to weaken to a tropical storm by Saturday as it nears the Big Island.
