Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Tropical Storm Hanna

- The system, which formed in the Gulf of Mexico as Tropical Depression Eight on Wednesday night, strengthened into a tropical storm late Thursday. It is the earliest H-named storm in an Atlantic basin hurricane season.
- The storm has sustained winds of 40 mph, with gusts of 50 mph, according to CNN meteorologist Robert Shackelford.
- Hanna is forecast to strengthen and it is expected to bring tropical-storm-force winds to portions of the Texas coast, where a tropical storm warning is in effect.
- Hanna is expected to produce heavy rains across portions of southern Texas. These rains could result in flash flooding and isolated minor to moderate river flooding.



Atlantic – Tropical Storm Gonzalo

- Tropical Storm Gonzalo, trying to become the first hurricane of the 2020 Atlantic hurricane season, is headed to the Windward Islands this weekend, but is expected to wither in the Caribbean Sea next week.
- Gonzalo's center is located several hundred miles east of the southern Windward Islands, moving west.
- Gonzalo's tiny size and the environment around it continue to pose a major forecast challenge for its future intensity.



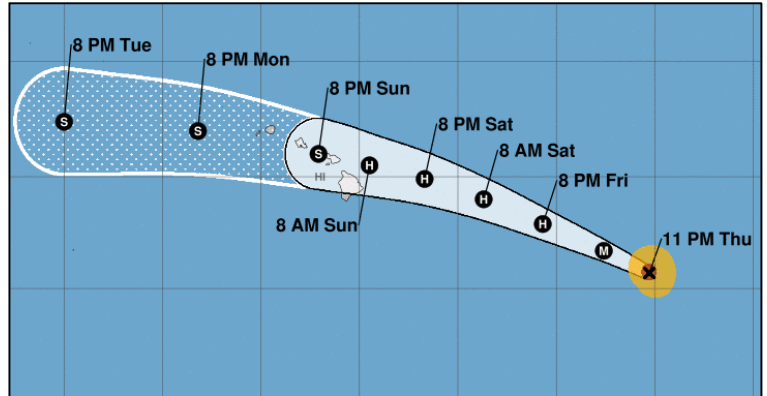

East Pacific – Hurricane Douglas

- Douglas churned into the Central Pacific as a Category 4 hurricane on Thursday night, bringing the threat of severe weather to the islands this weekend.
- At 11 p.m. Thursday, Douglas was located about 1,110 miles east-southeast of Hilo and packing maximum sustained winds near 130 mph with higher gusts.
- Douglas is expected to move near or over portions of the Hawaiian Islands this weekend.
- There is an increasing chance that strong winds, dangerous surf, and heavy rainfall could affect portions of the state beginning Saturday night or Sunday.
