## Tropical Activity

### Atlantic – Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine

- Located 350 miles ESE of San Juan, PR
- Maximum sustained winds of 45 mph; moving WNW at 23 mph
- Some increase in strength is forecast today, with weakening likely tomorrow due to land interaction.
- Some re-strengthening possible later this week.
- The system is forecast to move near or over the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico tonight.
- Tropical storm warnings in effect for Puerto Rico and the USVI
- Rain accumulations of 3 to 6 inches with maximum amounts of 10 inches forecast across USVI and PR.
- Life threatening flash flooding, mudslides, rip currents and potential riverine flooding possible.
- The NHC projected path below shows that this system could be located near or on either side of the Florida Peninsula by this weekend. However, it is still too early to be certain.



## Hurricane Hanna Aftermath

### Texas

- Hurricane Hanna made landfall over the weekend in South Texas and the Rio Grande Valley, causing widespread damage, heavy rain, flash flooding, riverine flooding, damage from hurricane-force winds, and dangerous rip currents.
- On Saturday, the Governor issued a disaster declaration for 32 counties and requested a Federal Emergency Declaration from President Donald Trump and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).
- Initial damage assessment of Kleberg and Nueces counties showed the areas of concern to be Baffin Bay, Loyola Beach, Ricardo, and Riviera.
- Power outages remain in Cameron County. One shelter remains open in La Feria.
- Willacy County: Power remains out for most of the county, with restoring estimates ranging from late today to Thursday. Communication is intermittent due to AT&T towers being out of order.
