Tropical Activity

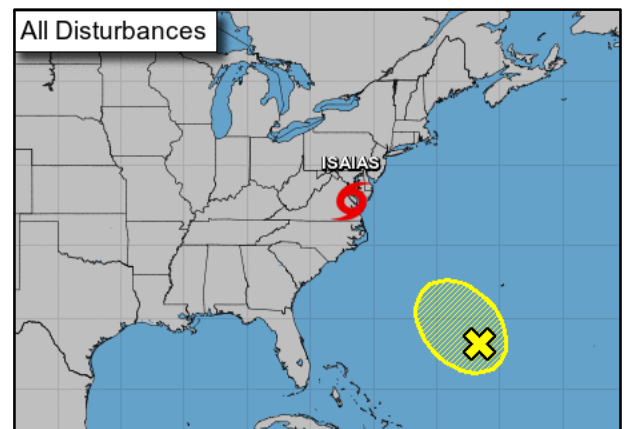
Atlantic – Tropical Storm Isaias

- Tropical Storm Isaias flooded cars and homes, knocked out power to hundreds of thousands and spawned deadly and destructive tornadoes from the Carolinas into Virginia Tuesday morning.
- The storm made landfall at 11:10 p.m. Monday at the South Carolina-North Carolina border as a Category 1 hurricane with maximum sustained winds of 85 mph.
- It was racing toward the northeast, and tropical storm warnings were raised as far north as Maine.
- More than 650,000 homes and businesses were without electricity as of 8 a.m. Tuesday, according to poweroutage.us. More than 360,000 of those were in North Carolina and 280,000 were in Virginia.
- As of 7 a.m. EDT Tuesday, there have been nearly a dozen reports of tornadoes from eastern North Carolina to the Delmarva Peninsula. That number is likely to climb through the day.
- One person was killed and others missing Tuesday after a tornado struck a mobile home park overnight in Windsor, North Carolina, Bertie County Sheriff John Holley told the Virginian Pilot.
- In Virginia, multiple businesses and homes in downtown Suffolk were damaged when a possible tornado touched about 3:15 a.m. Tuesday, WAVY reported.



Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Located about 300 miles south-southwest of Bermuda.
- Abundant dry air surrounding the system is likely to limit significant development.
- This system is forecast to move northwestward at about 10 mph over the southwestern Atlantic today, stall several hundred miles southwest of Bermuda tonight, and then drift southwestward on Thursday.
- Formation chance through 48 hours (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days (30%)
