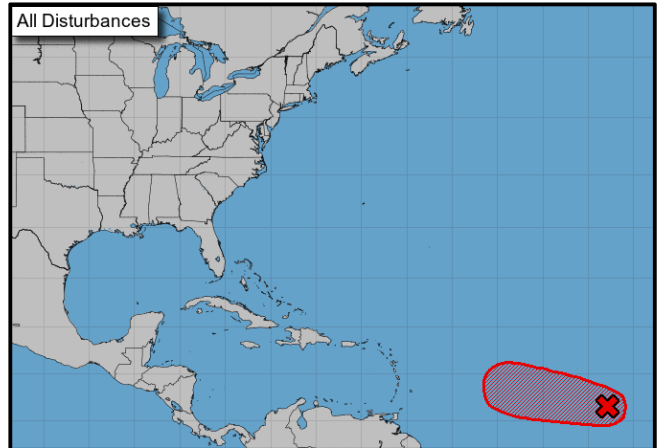

August 11, 2020

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- A disturbance in the Atlantic has a 90% chance of developing into a depression or a tropical storm in the next few days.
- The low-pressure system is located about 900 miles west-southwest of the Cabo Verde Islands.
- Over the next few days, the system is forecast to move west-northwestward at 15 mph across the tropical Atlantic.
- The NHC says environmental conditions will likely be more conducive for development, adding that advisories on a tropical depression could be issued as early as Tuesday.
- The storm has a 90% chance of developing into a depression or tropical storm over the next 48 hours into the next five days.
- Josephine will be the next named storm of the season.



Severe Weather Activity

Midwest

- A derecho raced eastward across the Midwest on Monday, Aug. 10, 2020, where it caused widespread damage to trees, structures and knocked out power to more than one million.
- NOAA's Storm Prediction Center says the derecho tracked about 770 miles in 14 hours, starting in southeast South Dakota and eastern Nebraska and moved through Iowa, northern and central Illinois, southern Wisconsin, southwest Michigan, Indiana and northwest Ohio.
- Several tornado warnings were issued in northern Illinois on Monday afternoon from near Rockford, Ill., to Chicago's north and west suburbs, including Evanston, Ill., as the Weather Service observed areas of enhanced winds on the leading edge of the line.
- One tornado probably did touch down near Lisbon, about 60 miles southwest of Chicago.
- Multiple locations in Iowa clocked wind gusts of 90 mph or greater, including a gust to 112 mph in Midway.
- Governor of Iowa declared a state of emergency.
