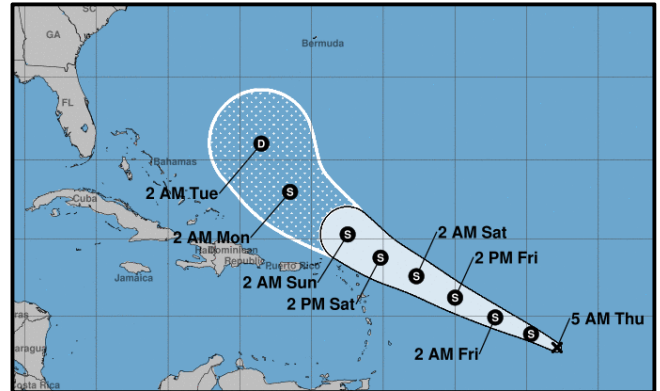

August 13, 2020

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Tropical Depression Eleven

- Located 1,075 miles ESE of the northern Leeward Islands
- Moving WNW at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds at 35 mph
- Expected to become a tropical storm later today



Severe Weather Activity

Iowa

- Gov. Kim Reynolds toured Eastern Iowa including Davenport and Scott County around noon Wednesday and called the destruction she's seen first-hand throughout the state "expansive and significant."
- As of Wednesday, 23 Iowa counties have requested state emergency disaster relief.
- 256K remain without power
- Several people were injured and widespread property damage was reported in Marshall County in central Iowa after 100 mph winds swept through the area, said its homeland security coordinator Kim Elder.
- As power is being restored, damage assessments are ongoing. The assessments are being conducted by city staff who are using the FEMA damage ranking system.

Hurricane Isaias Aftermath

North Carolina

- Work is still underway to bring power and water back to everyone on Oak Island (Brunswick County).
- Parts of the island were still locked down Wednesday as crews try to dig through feet of sand to make their repairs.
- Preliminary damage reports indicate Hurricane Isaias did \$10 million in home damage.
- At least 935 homes were damaged, along with portions of Ocean Crest Pier and motel. Seven houses were completely destroyed and 71 had damage of at least 50%, according to the town's assessment. Homes damaged at least 25% numbered 179, while 678 had less than 25% damage.
- Gov. Roy Cooper traveled to Oak Island Thursday, August 6, to speak with local officials and see firsthand the devastation caused by Hurricane Isaias.
- Cooper indicated he had spoken with President Donald Trump who said "the full force of the federal government would be available," and what North Carolina could qualify for will depend on the ongoing damage assessments.
