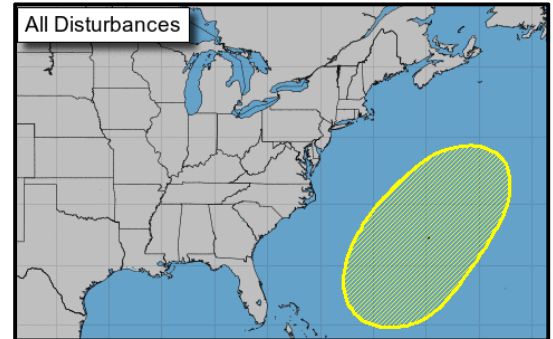

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Could form between the Bahamas and Bermuda by early next week.
- Gradual development possible
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)



Wildfire Activity

California

- A wildfire raging in a small community on the California-Nevada border destroyed dozens of buildings and killed at least one person.
- The so-called Mountain View Fire ignited during high winds on Tuesday. By Wednesday afternoon, it had burned more than 32 square miles in Mono County, California. Evacuation orders were issued in the communities of Walker, Coleville and Topaz.
- At least 90 buildings were destroyed. The fire was 20% contained and forward progress was stopped.
- The Associated Press reported that more than 100 residents were displaced by the fire. Many were being housed at a local hotel where the Red Cross set up an evacuation point.
- California Gov. Gavin Newsom issued a disaster declaration for the affected areas.



COVID-19 Update

- Dr. Anthony Fauci said at a White House briefing Thursday evening that a coronavirus vaccine will be available to "high priority" groups within the next six weeks.
- The news comes as COVID-19 deaths topped 250,000 in the United States, another grim milestone amid weeks of record case numbers, surging hospitalizations and dire warnings from health experts.
- Fauci added that things like mask-wearing and social distancing need to continue.
- Vaccine makers Pfizer and Moderna both announced this week that their vaccines proved more than 94% effective in trials.
- The number of deaths in the U.S. because of COVID-19 was 251,970 at the time of the briefing, according to data tracked by Johns Hopkins University. That's higher than any other country and accounts for nearly one-fifth of the 1.3 million deaths worldwide.
- More than 11.6 million people in the U.S. and 56 million worldwide have been infected since the pandemic started in early spring.

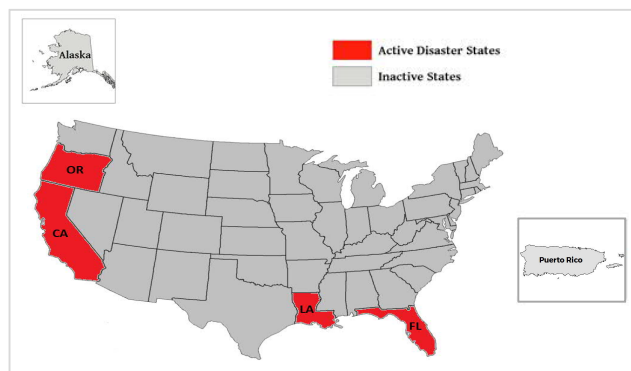
