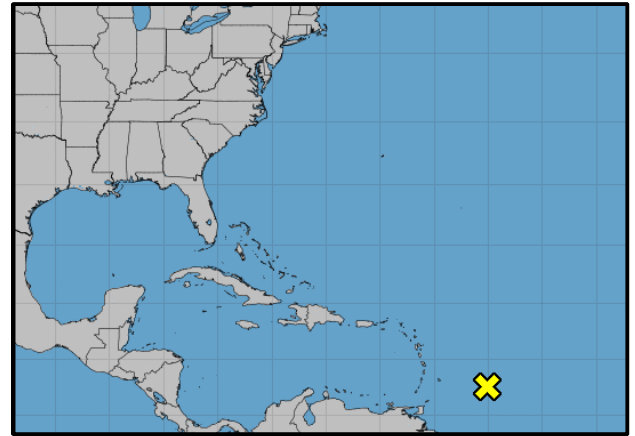

June 23, 2021

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Showers and thunderstorms associated with a tropical wave located a few hundred miles east of the Windward Islands remain disorganized.
- Additional development of this system is unlikely while moving west-northwestward at 5 to 10 mph into an area of stronger upper-level winds by Thursday
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (10%)



Tornado Activity

Illinois

- State authorities continue to provide assistance in the aftermath of the storm, as local authorities continue to assess the cost of a tornado that crashed into the area on Sunday.
- Alicia Tate Nado, director of the Illinois Federal Emergency Management Agency, visited various parts of the region on Tuesday to see what she witnessed and what the state is doing to help homeowners.
- Some 300 Woodridge homes were damaged by the E-F3 tornado that ripped through the village late Sunday, according to new data from village officials Tuesday evening.
- With Woodridge's damage assessment roughly 80 percent complete, over 700 homes had been evaluated by the village's Community Development Department. Per Tuesday's totals:
 - 140 homes had sustained "major damage"
 - 21 homes were deemed a "complete loss"
- Local officials met with Tate Nado to discuss the state's response. Authorities continue to assess the cost of damage, and it is unclear at this time whether state or federal governments will be required to support storm-affected communities.
- Senator John Curran, who visited the community on Tuesday, said his office is doing everything possible to ensure an accurate account of the damage and to seek as much help as possible from the population. say.

Wildfire Activity

Willow Fire

- The Willow fire in a remote area of Los Padres National Forest, ignited last Thursday night and has grown to 2,877 acres with zero containment by Tuesday evening, according to Inciweb, an interstate incident information system.
- According to the system, 526 firefighters are battling with the fire, however steepness of terrain, inaccessible wilderness, few roads, heavy fuels and poor radio communication post heavy challenges for the firemen to work.
- Due to the fire, the Monterey County Sheriff's Office on Monday issued evacuation orders for residents and many evacuation warnings for nearby communities.
