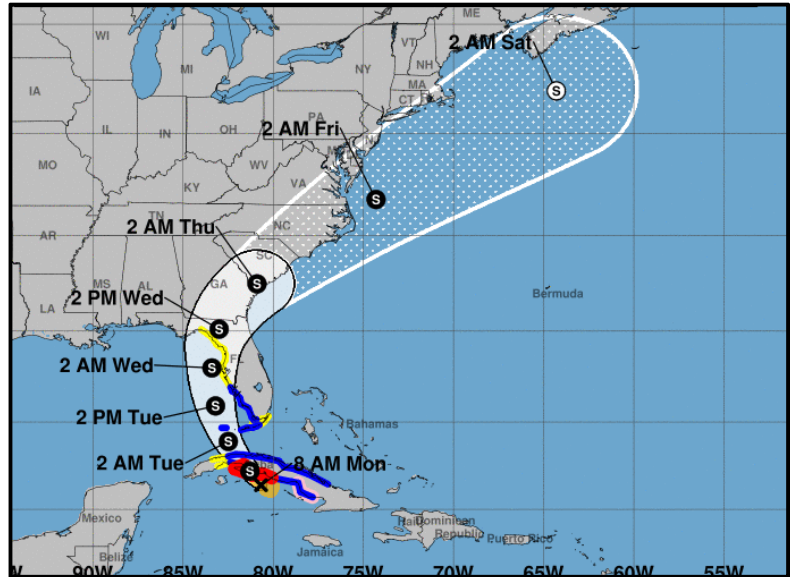

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Tropical Storm Elsa

- Tropical Storm Elsa is soaking Cuba and will then track toward Florida and the coastal Southeast United States, where impacts such as heavy rain, gusty winds and some storm surge are likely.
- Elsa's center is now nearing a landfall in central Cuba as it continues tracking northwest.
- Bands of heavy rain and gusty winds are affecting parts of Cuba and the Cayman Islands. More than 5 inches of rain had fallen in at least one location in Jamaica as of late Sunday morning.
- A tropical storm warning is in effect for portions of the Florida Keys, from Craig Key westward to the Dry Tortugas, and also along the west coast of Florida from Flamingo to Englewood. This includes Key West, Marco Island, Naples, and Sanibel Island. Tropical storm conditions (winds 39+ mph) are expected to begin in these areas tonight.
- Tropical storm watches have also been issued in other parts of Florida, from Craig Key eastward to Ocean Reef, including Florida Bay, and from Englewood northward along the west coast to the Aucilla River, including Tampa Bay. These areas could see tropical storm conditions by Tuesday.



Flood Activity

Michigan

- Mayor Mike Duggan is assuring Detroiters help to recover from the most recent flooding is on the way. That assistance is coming from the White House.
- President Joe Biden was in Michigan on Saturday.
- "He had time after doing all of the other things and sit down with me and talk about the flooding issues in Detroit," Duggan said. "He's been a huge Detroit supporter all along and he's going to help us."
- "He told his staff that he wanted the Emergency Order done for Detroit as fast as legally possible so we can get money into the hands of our residents for reimbursements as quickly as possible," Duggan said.
- It will be a busy week in Metro Detroit as FEMA officials are set to arrive in the area to assess flood damage on Thursday, July 8.
- FEMA officials are going to evaluate the damage the recent floods had on the region.
