Tropical Activity

Atlantic - Disturbance 1

- A large mass of showers and thunderstorms over the western Gulf of Mexico that AccuWeather meteorologists have dubbed a tropical rainstorm will spin onshore in Texas before the end of this week.
- While there is still time for the system to become a tropical depression prior to making landfall, the main impacts from the system will be flooding downpours and drought-easing rainfall as the storm moves inland, forecasters say.
- Shower and thunderstorm activity associated with the storm will remain isolated but generally limited to the upper Texas and Louisiana coasts into Thursday morning.
- However, as the system pivots northwestward, showers and thunderstorms will increase in frequency over much of eastern Texas and spread northward over western Louisiana and into southern Arkansas through the end of the week. In this zone, a general 1-2 inches of rain is in store, forecasters say.
- The heaviest rainfall will occur from near Houston to just east of Corpus Christi, northward to College Station, Texas, from Thursday to Friday where a general 4-8 inches is likely. There is the potential for an AccuWeather Local StormMax™ rainfall of 16 inches to be realized.
- There is a high risk of flooding downpours, especially in urban areas, from the central Texas coast through northeastern Texas and western Louisiana from Thursday into Friday evening.
- Most of the downpours and thunderstorms associated with the tropical rainstorm are likely to remain to the east of San Antonio and the Dallas metro area.
- Some of the more intense thunderstorms near the Texas coast will bring the risk of strong wind gusts, hail and an isolated tornado or waterspout.
