November 30, 2022

Severe Weather Activity

- Severe storms swept across the South on Tuesday evening as numerous strong, long-track tornadoes, destructive hail, damaging wind and flash flooding threatened the region.
- Two people were killed amid destructive severe weather Wednesday morning north of Montgomery, Alabama, according to county officials.
- Severe weather reports for tornadoes, wind damage and large hail stretch from Alabama, Mississippi and Louisiana into Kentucky over the past 24 hours. That includes 25 reports of tornadoes as of 6 a.m. EST.
- Some parts of the South, including between Huntsville and Birmingham in Alabama, saw between 2 and 4 inches of rain Tuesday.
- As of 8 a.m. CST, over 55,000 electric customers were without power across Louisiana, Mississippi, Tennessee and Alabama, according to PowerOutage.us.
- Threats of severe weather remained Wednesday morning. A tornado watch was in effect for parts of southern Alabama, the Florida Panhandle and extreme southwestern Georgia until 11 a.m. CT.
- "Thunderstorms capable of producing scattered damaging winds and a tornado or two will be possible" in these areas Wednesday morning, the Storm Prediction Center said.
- Storms are expected to diminish in coverage and intensity through the afternoon across southeast Georgia and north Florida.
