Winter Weather Outlook Mid-Atlantic & Northeast

- More snow is in the forecast this weekend for parts of the recently snow-fatigued Mid-Atlantic and New England, but it won't be a major snowstorm.
- This low-pressure will track east of the "40/70 benchmark" - or 40 degrees north latitude and 70 degrees west longitude - that typically means only a brush of snow in the East, rather than a major snowstorm.
- This will begin Saturday night, with snow possible from parts of North Carolina and Virginia into the Mid-Atlantic and possibly parts of the New York City tri-state and southern New England.
- This snow is expected to last into Sunday along parts of the Eastern Seaboard, though the timing of when it ends farther south in Virginia and North Carolina isn't yet clear in the forecast guidance.
- Some snow may linger in parts of southeast New England and possibly down east Maine Sunday night before ending.
- Accumulations are forecast to be light in most areas, generally on the order of a few inches from North Carolina to southern New England.
- Some of the most impressive snow surpluses this season have been along the Northeast coast.
- Atlantic City, New Jersey, had its record snowiest January (33.2 inches) from three separate winter storms.
