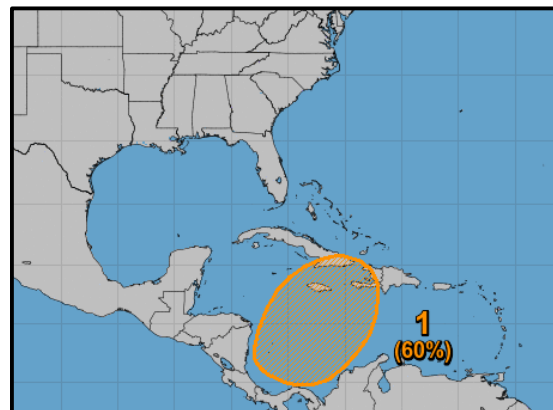

### Tropical Activity

#### Atlantic – Disturbance 1

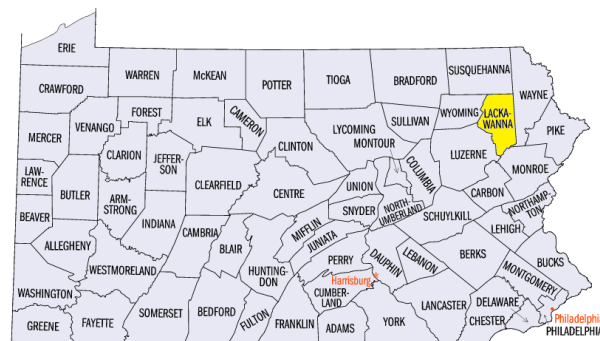
- A broad area of low pressure is expected to form over the southwestern Caribbean Sea in a few days.
- Gradual development of this system is possible, and a tropical depression could form late this week while the system begins moving northeastward across the western and central portions of the Caribbean Sea.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 7 days: Medium (60%)



### Declaration Requests

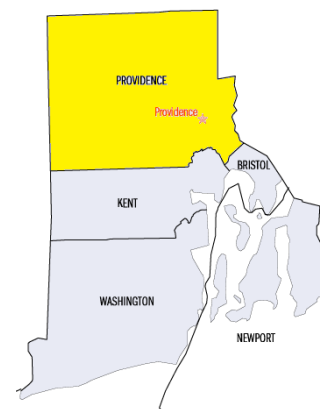
#### Pennsylvania

- Governor Shaprio’s team provided an update on the storm damage that occurred September 9-10, 2023, in Lackawanna, Luzerne, and Wyoming Counties.
- The brutal storm wrecked roads, damaged businesses, and homes, and even took a local woman’s life.
- After assessing the damage in three counties, Lackawanna, Luzerne, and Wyoming, officials state that Lackawanna County saw the worst of the storm.
- The flooding that hit Lackawanna County was intense. Several basements flooded with reports of up to five feet of water in some.
- The county declared itself in a state of emergency to effectively utilize all available resources.
- In Abington, the area saw close to 4 inches, approximately receiving 1 1/2 inches per hour.
- On November 8, 2023, Governor of Pennsylvania requested individual assistance for Lackawanna County.



#### Rhode Island

- Portions of northern Rhode Island were slammed with torrential, monsoonal rainfall September 10-11, 2023, flooding out neighborhoods and roads.
- Several inches of precipitation within the span of only a few hours caused havoc.
- Firefighters in Providence rescued more than two dozen people after flash flooding caused the West River to overflow and left 25 people stranded at a local shopping plaza.
- Dozens of residents of a Cranston, Rhode Island, apartment complex were displaced after flood water filled multiple ground floor apartments on Sunday.
- The National Weather Service confirmed two tornadoes touched down in Rhode Island on September 13, 2023.

- Two EF1 tornadoes touched down in Glocester and Lincoln, Rhode Island with maximum wind speeds of 100 mph.
- On November 8, 2023, Governor of Rhode Island requested individual assistance for Providence County.

## Severe Weather & Flooding Activity

### Puerto Rico (Oct 26-31)

- Heavy flooding struck Puerto Rico's capital city, San Juan, on Friday, October 27, as the area experienced a historic record for daily maximum rainfall, according to the National Weather Service (NWS) of San Juan.
- The NWS reported that San Juan experienced an unprecedented daily rainfall of 5.20 inches on October 27, breaking the previous record of 1.4 inches set in 1941.
- The torrential rains caused flooding, sinkholes and landslides in several towns.
- Governor Pedro Pierluisi Urrutia declared a state of emergency on October 29th for the municipalities of San Juan, Guaynabo and Loiza.
