Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

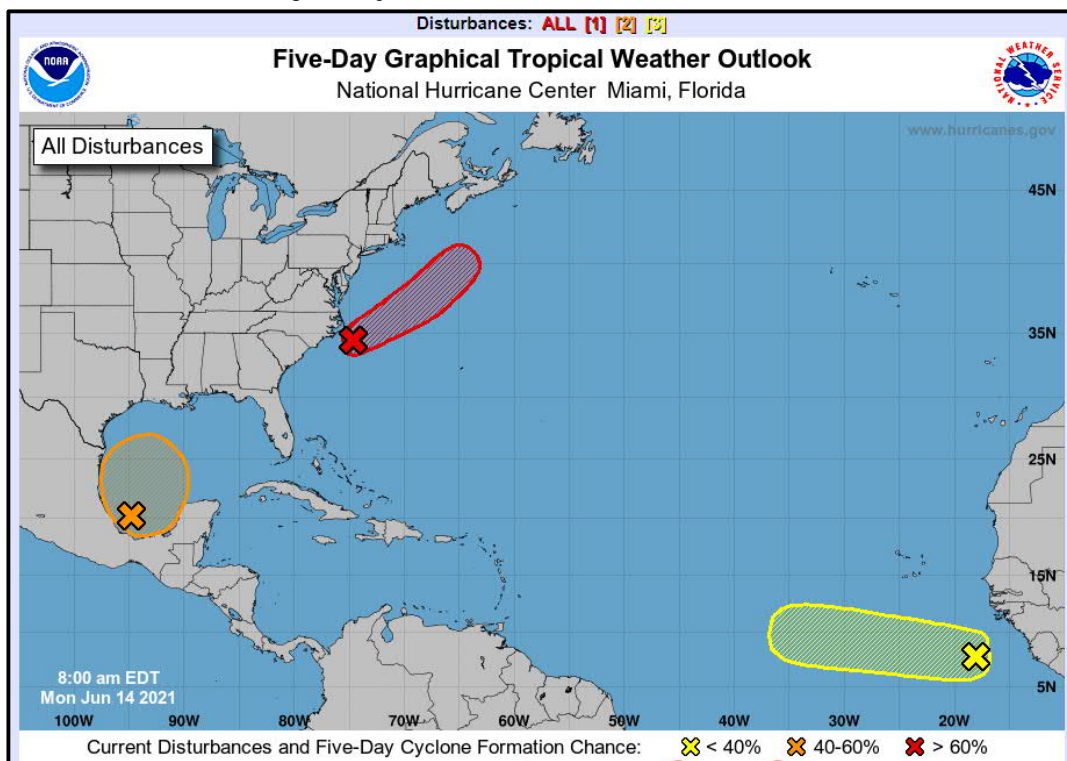
- Located about 90 miles SE of Cape Hatteras, North Carolina.
- Environmental conditions appear conducive for further development, and a tropical depression or tropical storm is likely to form later today or tonight.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...high...70%
- Formation chance through 5 days...high...70%

Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- Located over the Bay of Campeche.
- Slow development possible and a tropical depression could form over the next couple of days.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...20%
- Formation chance through 5 days...medium...60%

Atlantic – Disturbance 3

- A strong tropical wave just offshore of west Africa is producing disorganized shower and thunderstorm activity.
- Some development of this system is possible during the next few days.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...10%
- Formation chance through 5 days...low...20%
