Severe Weather Outlook

Southeast

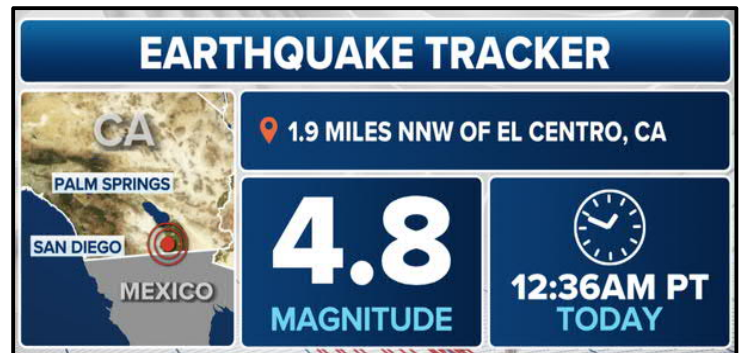
- Severe thunderstorms are expected from the Gulf Coast to the Southeast on Monday, bringing threats of damaging winds and a possible tornado spin-up for Georgia and Alabama.
- NOAA's Storm Prediction Center issued a Level 2 out of 5 risk for severe thunderstorms from Monday morning from the ArkLaTex into the Tennessee Valley, including Atlanta and Columbus, Georgia: Mobile, Montgomery and Birmingham, Alabama.
- Damaging wind gusts and tornadoes are all possible as the storms fire up throughout Monday morning and into the evening hours.
- Storms will begin early Monday for southern Mississippi, Alabama, and the Florida Panhandle, where a few supercells with damaging winds could pose a tornado risk.
- Additionally, a flash flood threat will set up in a corridor from Louisiana into Georgia, the FOX Forecast Center said.
- Between 3 and 5 inches of rain is forecast for the greater Atlanta area through Monday.



Earthquake Activity

Southern California

- A series of over a dozen earthquakes rattled parts of Southern California early Monday, with residents of San Diego reportedly feeling the shaking.
- According to the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS), the earthquake swarm began at 12:36 a.m. PST (3:36 a.m. EST) when a magnitude 4.8 quake occurred just under 2 miles north-northwest of El Centro, California.
- At least 16 aftershocks followed that temblor over the next two hours, ranging from magnitude 2.5 to 3.9, all centered near El Centro in Imperial County.
- El Centro is about 30 miles east of the San Diego County border and over 100 miles from San Diego proper, but residents of the city submitted reports of weak shaking to the USGS.
- There have been no reports of any damage from the series of early-morning quakes in Southern California.
