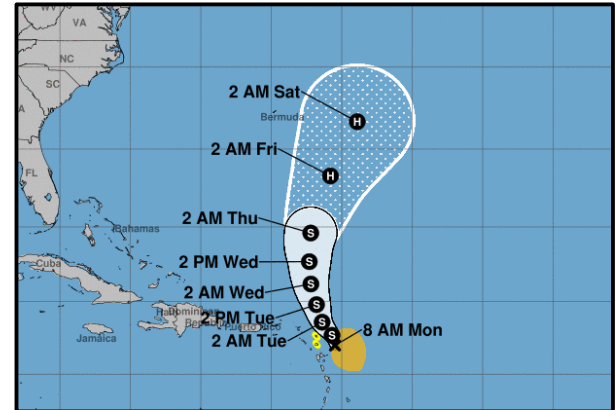

October 2, 2023

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Tropical Storm Philippe

- Located 95 miles ESE of Barbuda moving WNW at 7 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 50 mph.
- Little change in strength forecast during the next 48 hours.
- Could begin to intensify more significantly during the middle of the week.



Severe Weather & Flood Activity

New York

- A coastal storm unleashed a deluge of heavy rain on the New York City Tri-State area from late Thursday night into Friday night, leading to flash flooding, stranded motorists, street closures, subway suspensions and hundreds of flight delays and cancellations.
- As the flash flood emergency unfolded, New York Gov. Kathy Hochul declared a State of Emergency across New York City, Long Island and the Hudson Valley.
- As the heaviest rain ended Saturday morning, a total of 5.90 inches of rain had fallen at New York's Central Park.
- There were also reports of more than 9 inches of rain in the Gowanus and Park Slope neighborhoods in Brooklyn.
- Flooding across the Hudson Valley has receded, but thousands of homes and businesses will be dealing with the damage for weeks, and perhaps months.
- Mamaroneck was one of the hardest hit areas from Friday's devastating rain, and while all roads reopened over the weekend, it will be some time before everyone has recovered.
- At least 28 rescues were conducted by New York emergency services.
- New York Gov. Kathy Hochul said on Saturday morning that she'd spoken "with the White House yesterday, and I spoke with majority leader [Sen Chuck] Schumer, who contacted me immediately. "They're prepared to support an emergency declaration, a declaration of disaster, from the federal government, if necessary. There is a threshold that has to be met – \$30m worth of damage ...it'll take a number of weeks for us to add up and calculate that."
