Flood Risk

Tennessee

- Flooding risks continue in Middle Tennessee on Thursday as rain continues to fall.
- A flood watch is in effect for much of the region until 6 a.m. Friday, with heavy rain possible throughout the day today, the National Weather Service said.
- "Excessive runoff may result in flooding of rivers, creeks, streams, and other low-lying and flood-prone locations," NWS said. "You should monitor later forecasts and be alert for possible flood warnings. Those living in areas prone to flooding should be prepared to take action should flooding develop."
- Officials reported several road closures due to flooding across the region Thursday morning. The Wilson County Sheriff's Office said it had also performed water rescues.
- A flood watch is in effect through 6 a.m. Friday for the following counties: Cannon, Cheatham, Clay, Cumberland, Davidson, De Kalb, Dickson, Fentress, Hickman, Houston, Humphreys, Jackson, Lewis, Macon, Maury, Montgomery, Overton, Perry, Pickett, Putnam, Robertson, Rutherford, Smith, Stewart, Sumner, Trousdale, Wayne, White, Williamson and Wilson.
- Around 1-2 inches fell in the last six hours, with another 1-2 inches expected throughout the morning, NWS Nashville tweeted at 6:30 a.m. Thursday.
- The region has seen roughly 2-3 inches of rain so far this week, with some locally higher amounts, NWS Nashville Meteorologist Mark Rose said Wednesday night.
