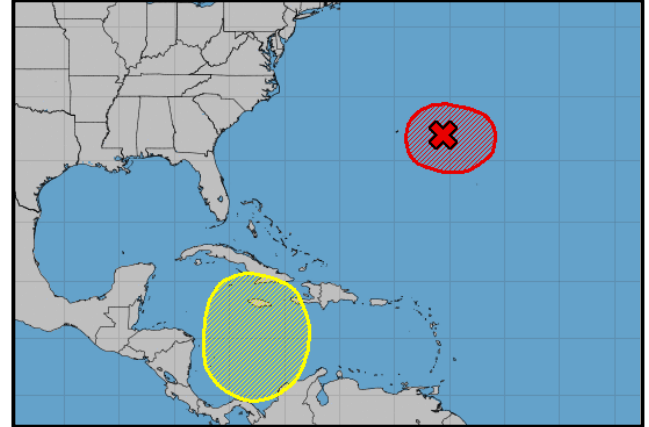

## Tropical Activity

### Atlantic – Disturbance 1 (Formerly TC Tammy)

- Located a few hundred miles E of Bermuda.
- Conditions forecast to be more conducive over the NW Atlantic to the E of Bermuda through Saturday.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (70%); 7-day: High (70%)



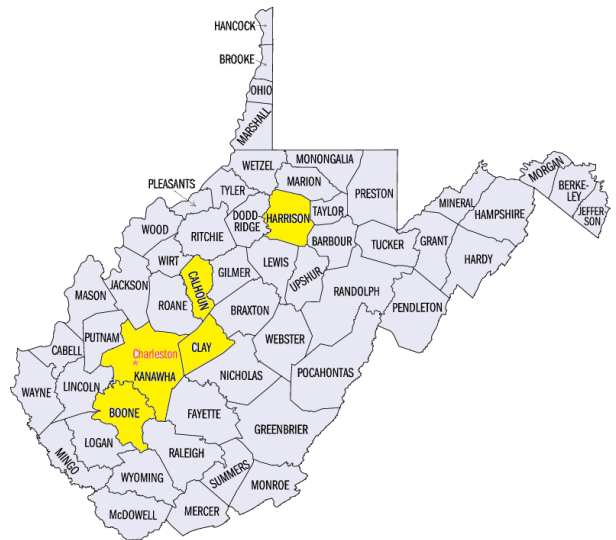
### Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- Located over SW Caribbean Sea.
- Conditions could support some slow development of this system early next week while moving north.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (Near 0%); 7-day: Low (30%)

## Declaration Request

### West Virginia

- Heavy rain and flash floods tore through parts of West Virginia on the morning of August 28th, prompting emergency water rescues and evacuations, as residents were instructed to seek higher ground, the authorities said.
- Over five hours, the National Weather Service recorded between three and six inches of rainfall in the Upper Kanawha Valley area near the capital, Charleston, with radar picking up more than eight inches of rain in some areas.
- Kent Carper, president of the Kanawha County Commission, estimated that “dozens and dozens and dozens” of residents had been rescued, including people trapped in cars and even emergency responders, and that over the course of the morning the emergency communications center received more than 700 calls.
- An estimated 100 or more homes were significantly damaged, and a local fire station experienced significant water damage, he added.
- The governor of West Virginia, Jim Justice, declared a state of emergency in Kanawha, Braxton, Calhoun, Clay and Roane Counties.
- On October 25<sup>th</sup>, governor of West Virginia requested individual assistance for 5 counties (Boone, Calhoun, Clay, Harrison and Kanawha).
