January 11, 2022

Flood Activity Pacific Northwest

- The waters are receding, the passes are being cleared, but last week's heavy weather will leave a lingering impact on many families living along the Chehalis River.
- As rain poured down across Washington late last week, the Chehalis saw record-breaking flooding as water overflowed the river's bounds, wreaking havoc on a number of small communities.
- After a short weekend break in the action, steady rain and mountain snow returned to the Pacific Northwest on Monday.
- Locally heavy rainfall began Monday night in Washington, especially on the Olympic Peninsula and the Cascades.
- Another round of heavy rain is anticipated on Tuesday night through Wednesday for the area.
- "Flooding is possible in areas near the coast to the mountains in western Washington," explained AccuWeather Lead Long-Range Meteorologist Paul Pastelok.



Severe Weather Activity

Texas

- The National Weather Service has confirmed at least six tornadoes touched down across southeast Texas late Saturday night and early Sunday morning.
- The sixth tornado was confirmed in the Spring Branch area. Officials say it is mostly EF0, but with some EF1 damage. The estimated winds reached 90 mph.
- On Sunday, the NWS confirmed five other tornadoes touched down in Humble, Kingwood, Montgomery and Dayton. Crews are continuing to survey damage Monday and possibly confirm additional tornadoes.
- All of the tornadoes reported across the region were considered lower-end, EF0 or EF1 tornadoes on the Fujita scale.
- Amazingly, no known injuries had been reported as a result of the severe weather.
